HOW TO GET HERE

Our Residency Centre, FIAP Jean Monnet, is located at

30 rue Cabanis, 75014 Paris.



You can get to FIAP Centre by Uber or Taxi available at any airport and train station in Paris, or by many convenient public transportation options.

From Charles de Gaulle (CDG) airport: take the RER B train to Denfert-Rochereau station - FIAP is just a 10-minute walk. The RER station for Terminal 2 is right inside the terminal, but for Terminal 1 you will need to take an airport shuttle train (called CDGVal) to the RER train station. This shuttle is free and goes every 2-3 minutes. If you take a train, keep your train ticket, as you will need it not only to enter the station at the airport, but also to exit the station when in Paris.

From the ORLY airport: our advice would be to take the *OrlyBus* which goes toward the Denfert-Rochereau square right in Montparnasse, and get off one stop before (at Alesia), just a ~5mins walk to FIAP.

From Gare du Nord & Gare de l'Est: take the RER B train to Denfert-Rochereau station - FIAP is just a 10-minute walk.

From Paris Gare de Lyon: take metro line 14 one stop to Bercy station, change to line 6 towards Glacière – a 550-meter walk to FIAP.

You can also book a shuttle from the airport to the centre via private company such as: www.shuttledirect.com

TRANSPORTATION

Paris Métro:

To travel by metro, bus, tram, RER train within central Paris, and even on the Funiculaire de Montmartre we advise to use Ticket T+. It can be bought at any metro station booth or machine. Single trip ticket costs € 1.90, but you can buy 10 tickets with 25% discount, for € 14.90. More info: <https://www.ratp.fr/titres-et-tarifs/ticket-t>

Note, that the T+ ticket will not work for the airport travel; you will need a separate airport ticket, which can also be purchased at any metro station.

PRACTICAL TIPS

Foreign Plugs:

French voltage is 220-230 V, so a 50 Hz. U.S./ Canadian, Japanese (and perhaps some other) appliances/electric devices may require a step-down transformer for use in France. Please check if your device works in 220V. If not, and you only use an adaptor plug, your device will be damaged and probably destroyed. If in doubt, don't plug it in!

Your computer will almost certainly offer dual voltage, and will thus need only an adaptor plug. Please verify you have the right plug before plugging it in. Please arrive equipped with the necessary transformers and adaptor plugs for France. Please label your cables, plug adaptors, etc., with your name to avoid confusion over who owns what.

Cell/Mobile telephones:

It is generally a good idea to purchase a local SIM card. Before departure, please make sure your phone is unlocked and can be used abroad if you intend to do so. At the airport, you can purchase a prepaid SIM card at a Relay kiosk. There are multiple Relay locations in all Paris area airports:

When already in the city, the best place to purchase would be in companies' boutiques, for example, at various locations of Boutique Orange. (Orange is the largest French mobile operator).

Security:

Please keep your room locked if you have anything of value in it. Please do not leave cameras, computers, etc., in a public space. There are lockers at the reception desk if wish to store your valuables.

ATMS, BANKS AND CURRENCY EXCHANGE

ATM Cards & Credit Cards:

Many French cash-points and commerces do not accept the common U.S. swipe-cards, but require chip-and-pin cards. Please ask your bank to issue you a chip-and-pin card for use in Europe. Note that ticket machines in train and metro stations *only* accept chip-and-pin cards.

Founded in 1887 by the craftsman of color, Gustave Sennelier, who closely collaborated and provided art materials to his many renowned painters, such as Paul Cezanne, Pierre Bonnard, Vassily Kandinsky, Sonia Delaunay, Salvador Dalí, Pablo Picasso, Jean Cocteau and more recent to Hans Hartung, Olivier Debre, David Hockney.

Adam Montparnasse

Les Catacombes

Six million bones, from different Parisian cemeteries, lie in the 1.7 km long labyrinth galleries. An unusual and fascinating visit!

The park: An ecological park, with 40 houses from around the world built by great architects.

Accessible to public, every day, from 7 am to 10 pm.

Guided tours: Throughout the year, guided tours are available for groups, from Monday to Sunday, morning or afternoon and for individuals every Sunday at 2:30 pm. The reservation is mandatory for individuals.

Theatre: True to Parisian arts and culture, Théâtre de la Cité Internationale offers a bold and eclectic program (theater, dance, circus, puppetry, music, etc.) advocating diversity and openness to all artistic expressions and backgrounds.

The place often organizes festivals, conferences, courses and much more!

WALKS

Parc Montsouris

Park Montsouris is one of the largest green spaces of Paris. Montsouris Park has a lake, beautiful sculpture monuments, remarkable trees, and is also a home to many bird species. From May to September, you can also enjoy free concerts at the park.

Les jardins de l'hôpital Sainte-Anne

These are the gardens of the Saint Anne Hospital, that was built in 1867 by Charles-Auguste Questel, according to Baron Haussmann's wishes. Located on a terrain full of quarries and catacombs, the different pavilions are connected to by a network of covered walkways with many green spaces and a botanical trail.

Maison de Simone De Beauvoir

Simone de Beauvoir (1908-1986), author, writer, philosopher, lived in this house from 1955 to 1986. (Please note, the building is a private property and can only be viewed from outside)

Maison de Jean Moulin

Jean Moulin lived in this house from April to June 1943 (1899-1943). He was a Chief of the Resistance, delegate General de Gaulle. (Please note, the building is a private property and can only be viewed from outside)

Street Art à la Butte-aux-Cailles

Posters, collages, stencils and graffiti exist in harmony with the inhabitants of a neighborhood as an open-air museum: some street artists have even made one of their favorite places of expression. Artists: Jef Aérosol, Miss Tic, Jace, Seth, Urban Solid, K-Bal, etc

La petite Alsace (Little Alsace)

Placed between two little pavilions, a large wooden gate opens onto a rectangular garden of 550 square meters lined with small pavilions in half-timbered Alsatian style bricks.

Search for the artist burials of Chaim Soutine, Man Ray, Ossip Zadkine, Constantin Brâncuși, Brassai, and Tristan Tzara. There you can also find the tombs of Charles Baudelaire, Guy de Maupassant, Jean-Paul Sartre, Simone de Beauvoir.
